

1853 TAX REGISTER OF DOUKHOBORS IN THE CAUCASUS

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INTRODUCTION

The *1853 Tax Register of Doukhobors in the Caucasus* is perhaps one of the most important sources for Doukhobor genealogical research in Russia. The information contained in this book derives from the original Russian records housed at the Georgian State Archives in Tbilisi, Georgia.¹ Translated into English, this information is now made available to Doukhobor family historians and genealogists for the first time. By listing the names and ages of the taxpaying population of each village, the *1853 Tax Register of Doukhobors in the Caucasus* makes possible a comprehensive and detailed reconstruction of the Doukhobor population and settlements in the Caucasus mountain region of Russia in the year 1853. As a result of this book, it is now possible to trace many Doukhobor families back to the late 18th century in Russia.

Historical Background of Doukhobor Settlement in the Caucasus

Doukhobor settlement in the Caucasus began in 1830, when Tsar Nicholas I issued a decree that all members of the religious sect were to be relocated there by either forcible exile or voluntarily resettlement. The main objective of the decree was to isolate the religious dissenters on the frontier of the Empire where they would be unable to spread their "heresy" among Orthodox Russians. This would rid the central provinces of the Empire of what Tsarist officials considered a significant threat to state power and the social order. The decree's second objective was to eliminate the religious dissenters either by exterminating them or converting them to Orthodoxy. Relocation to this remote and dangerous region rife with disease, inhospitable climate and hostile mountain tribes was considered the equivalent of a death sentence. Faced with this prospect, some Doukhobors might be convinced to return to Orthodoxy. The third objective of the decree was to ensure that the religious dissenters would nevertheless fulfill duties beneficial to the Empire. That is, the Doukhobor colonists would assist in Tsarist empire-building by developing, populating and "Russianizing" the newly conquered region.

The Doukhobors relocated to the Caucasus in three more or less well-defined waves, in 1830, 1841-1845 and from 1842 onwards. These relocations were not to be taken lightly, for the journey involved great hardship and suffering. The Doukhobors frequently had to sell their few possessions in haste, for a fraction of their value, in order to begin the journey to the Caucasus. The journey often lasted several months and involved thousands of miles on the road. The settlers journeyed in large groups; adults walked the entire distance, while children rode in wagons. They were escorted by military detachments. Nights were spent in crowded, squalid way stations. Dried food had to be eaten, the water supply was often inadequate, and disease frequently struck the settlers while on the road. Families were transformed during those months: mothers gave birth, some settlers died, some fell in love, livestock perished or, as the only available food, was consumed. Some settlers underwent a change of heart about resettlement and took the only action that would let them return to their original homes: conversion to

Orthodoxy. Most, however, remained firm in their faith. By the time the settlers arrived in the Caucasus, many were exhausted, ragged and starving.

The following is a general description of each of the three waves of Doukhobor settlement in the Caucasus:

Wave 1: The first wave of Doukhobor settlement took place in 1830 with the exile of 265 Doukhobors from the Don region to Karabakh province. The subtropical lowlands chosen for them turned out to be uninhabitable because of their remote and inaccessible location, debilitating heat and humidity, undrinkable water and unsuitable soil for their accustomed crops. As a result, many of the settlers perished from disease and exhaustion. In the first year alone, fifty-eight of the 265 settlers died while fifty converted to Orthodoxy in order to leave the Caucasus immediately. After petitioning Tsarist officials repeatedly pleading for resettlement, in 1842, the survivors were finally permitted to relocate to the Elizavetpol district in Tiflis province where they united with the Doukhobors of Wave 2.

Wave 2: The second (and by far the largest) wave of Doukhobor settlement took place between 1841 and 1845. During that period, 4,992 Doukhobors from Tavria province were exiled to the Akhalkalaki district in Kutaisi province, migrating there in five different parties over the four-year period. The mountain highlands initially chosen for them were 8,000 feet above sea level and experienced long winters, deep snow, frosts, hail and rocky, mountainous soil. Many of the settlers suffered failed harvests because of the climate and elevation. Famine and destitution followed. After petitioning Tsarist officials demanding aid and resettlement, over a third of the settlers were permitted to relocate to the Borchalo and Elizavetpol districts in Tiflis province. There, the mountain lowlands chosen for them were only 5,500 feet above sea level and enjoyed milder climates and more fertile soils. Still, these areas, too, suffered from long winters, snow and short growing seasons. Notwithstanding these difficult conditions, only a handful of families from Wave 2 chose to convert to Orthodoxy in order to leave the Caucasus.

Wave 3: The third wave of Doukhobor settlement took place from 1842 onwards, as small groups of Doukhobors, primarily from Tambov and Voronezh provinces, trickled into the Caucasus almost continually. Many relocated on a voluntary basis, seeking escape from persecution, greater spiritual freedom, a better material life, or to join relatives and co-religionist already in the Caucasus. Most were permitted to settle in the Elizavetpol district in Tiflis province where they united with the Doukhobors of Wave 2.

Despite the initial hardships on the Caucasian frontier, the Doukhobors persevered. They set to work clearing woodlands to make way for fields, pastures and villages; building houses, barns and mills; damming rivers in order to bring water to their villages; and carving out access roads through the mountains to their new villages. At the same time, the settlers adapted their way of life to conform to the demands of their new environment. They changed the way they tilled the soil, planted different kinds of crops, cultivated them in new ways and altered the timing of their sowing and harvesting to match the growing season. Many diversified their agricultural practices by focussing on livestock

breeding, particularly of sheep, cattle, and horse, but also including such activities as bee keeping and fishing. Others branched out into the transportation trade, carting freight on their wagons throughout the Caucasus. In the long term, these adaptations ensured their survival. Indeed, through their hard-working lifestyle and diligence, the Doukhobors overcame the disadvantages of their new situation to such an extent that by the 1850's, their settlements were among the most prosperous, productive and advanced in the Caucasus. They had transformed their tracts of isolated mountain wilderness into peaceful, civilized, agrarian settlements structured according to their religious principles – a veritable “land of Doukhobors”.

The Taxation Register

In 1853, in response to the massive influx of Russian sectarian settlers to the Caucasus, Tsarist officials ordered and compiled a special register of the taxable population (*kameral'noe osipanie*). The purpose of the register was to determine the size, distribution and composition of the population for taxation purposes. It was arranged by province (*gubernia*) and within provinces by district (*uezd*) and sub-district (*uchastok*).

The 1853 taxation register includes detailed information about the Doukhobors, who as state peasants settled on state land, paid taxes to the Tsar's treasury. Therefore, it is an important source of data about their population and settlement in the Caucasus.

According to the taxation register, the Doukhobor population in the Caucasus numbered 5,277 persons in 1853.² The Doukhobor population was concentrated in the sub-districts of Elizavetpol and Borchalo in Tiflis province and the sub-district of Akhalkalaki in Kutaisi province, where they formed the majority of Russian settlers. Within these three districts, the Doukhobors were distributed in sixteen village settlements. A detailed breakdown of the Doukhobor population by village is provided in Tables 1-3 below:

² The statistics for 1853 suggest only a modest increase in the Doukhobor population when compared to the original number of Doukhobors exiled to the Caucasus in the 1830's and 1840's. However, the actual population increase may be significantly higher if one takes into account the very high death rates among the settlers during their first years in the Caucasus, combined with the rates of conversion to Orthodoxy.

Of enormous importance to Doukhobor family historians and genealogists are the village schedules of the 1853 taxation register. Arranged by village (*selo*) and within villages by household (*dvor*), these schedules contain detailed family information and include: (a) the name, patronymic and surname of each male member of the household. Note that the names of women were not included because taxes in Russia at the time were calculated according to the number of males per household; (b) the family relationship to the head of the household (i.e. step-son, uncle, nephew, etc.); (c) the age of each male member of the household; (d) the year of arrival from Russia; (e) the total number of males per household; and (f) the total number of females per household. These schedules were supplemented with new information from time to time, such as when a male member of the household died, relocated to another village, converted to Orthodoxy, or if he was excluded from the list due to old age or illness.

The information contained in the village schedules of the 1853 taxation register have been translated into English and published in this book for use in Doukhobor genealogy and family history research.

About this Book

In order to use the *1853 Tax Register of Doukhobors in the Caucasus* for genealogical research, the reader must first trace his or her Doukhobor family back to a male ancestor who was alive in 1853 at the time the register was taken. This book can then be used to locate additional family information for that individual.

The surnames that appear in this book are the original Russian surnames, transliterated using the U.S. Library of Congress System. Readers familiar with the modern English spelling of a surname (i.e. Sheloff) may use the Appendix to cross-reference to the original Russian spelling (i.e. Shilov). The reader may then consult the Index to identify the pages on which that surname is listed.

This book is intended to provide easier access to this valuable information. Readers are encouraged to use it as a finding aid and to look at original copies of the 1853 tax register which are available through the Georgian State Archives or the Saskatchewan Archives.
